PLAYER GUIDE

Object of the game: Be the first player to hold 20 gems.

- 1. Shuffle all cards into one deck and place in the middle.
- 2. Youngest player goes first.
- 3. The person on their left (the reader) draws the top card from the deck and asks the player the question.
- 4. The player decides whether this statement is PROOF or PHONY.

- If the player answers correctly, they keep the card and earn a gem. Play then moves to the left.
- If the player answers incorrectly, their turn ends and the card is returned to the bottom of the deck. Play then moves to the left.
- If a Wild Card is drawn, the player must follow the instructions.The Wild Card is then returned to the bottom of the deck.
- 3. The first player to earn 20 gems wins the game!!


