

<p style="text-align: center;">PLAYER GUIDE</p> <p>Object of the game: Be the first player to hold 20 gems.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shuffle all cards into one deck and place in the middle. 2. Youngest player goes first. 3. The person on their left (the reader) draws the top card from the deck and asks the player the question. 4. The player decides whether this statement is PROOF or PHONY. <p>Source: Spin Master Inc. (2011)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. If the player answers correctly, they keep the card and earn a gem. Play then moves to the left. 6. If the player answers incorrectly, their turn ends and the card is returned to the bottom of the deck. Play then moves to the left. 7. If a Wild Card is drawn, the player must follow the instructions. The Wild Card is then returned to the bottom of the deck. 8.
