USE FOR: PSYCHOEDUCATION, PART II

Material: “Clues” or “Case Questions” typed on note cards, short story about sexual abuse (pgs. 26-29 of the book *“It Happens to Boys Too”* have some examples, the story about Frank works well), some kind of prize at the end when the client solves the case (such as a certificate for completing “Detective Academy”, an extra prize out of the prize box, or whatever you think would appeal to the client)

How to Play: Prior to the session, hide the note cards around the room. Read the story about Sexual Abuse and then explain to the client that they are going to be a Detective. Have the client search for the clues around the room to help the person in the story have a deeper understanding of what happened to them.
