Detective

USE FOR: PSYCHOEDUCATION, PART II

Material: "Clues" or "Case Questions" typed on note cards, short story about sexual abuse (pgs. 26-29 of the book "It Happens to Boys Too" have some examples, the story about Frank works well), some kind of prize at the end when the client solves the case (such as a certificate for completing "Detective Academy", an extra prize out of the prize box, or whatever you think would appeal to the client)

How to Play: Prior to the session, hide the note cards around the room. Read the story abuse Sexual Abuse and then explain to the client that they are going to be a Detective. Have the client search for the clues around the room to help the person in the story have a deeper understanding of what happened to them.
